

Cheap and Private Phone Service

Looking for a VERY economical home phone service that can reject ALL robocalls? Check out **magicJack**! I have been using my **magicJack** for about 10 years. It is currently wired to two desk phones, but I've had it connected to three phones in the past. The average fixed cost is about \$3.30/month for the service. However, you need an internet service for it to connect to the outside world. (MagicJack uses Voice Over Internet Technology - VoIP technolgy)

The device is very small, and has 3 connections: USB power, Ethernet cable, and phone cable. There are no buttons or switches. A power supply with USB output (not shown) is included.



<u>Cost</u>

The device currently costs about \$49.99, which includes one year of service. Service renewal is \$43 for 1 year (\$3.58/mo.), or \$109 for 3 years (\$3.04/mo.). Calls to anywhere in the U.S. and Canada are no extra charge, as are calls to any **magicJack** in the world.

Robocalls

To block ALL robocalls, select Automated Call Screening under the Call Features tab. It's a simple on/off switch on that web page. Anyone who calls you is asked to press a random 1 digit number from 0 to 9. To date, no calling robot has figured out how to press one of those numbers. Let's hope that continues.

magicJack on-the-go

The magicApp is a no-extra-charge feature that lets you send and receive calls from anywhere you can get an internet connection. There is a magicApp for Apple and Android. You can only use one magicApp per magicJack phone number.

How long will I keep my computer?

"The length of computer ownership varies significantly. While the average ownership period is surprisingly short at just 18 months, this statistic is heavily influenced by early adopters and executives who regularly upgrade to the latest technology.

Speaking from personal experience, I kept my first computer for nearly 10 years and my second for 7 years. This longer ownership period is more typical for users who focus on functionality rather than having cuttingedge specifications.

For most users who primarily need their computer for standard tasks, you can expect to keep your computer for 3-7 years, depending on your needs and how well you maintain it. There's often no need to upgrade simply because newer models are available if your current machine meets your requirements."



Bitcoin

Digital Currency No Banks of Government






